

It requires discerning in our world the signs of hope that show that something new is being born However, we must also discern those signs that point to situations in need of Salvation that today would move Jeanne de Lestonnac and make her understand that it was she who would have to extend a hand.

The truth is that we are thirsty for good news because human beings have an enormous capacity to desire, to dream, to aspire to what is good.

Jesus turns to us and commands us to proclaim the "Good News" (the Gospel) to all.
